



Colloquium in Academic Preparation for Sri Lankan Educators (CAPSLE) January 11-14, 2026

Summary

Sri Lanka's first Colloquium in Academic Preparation for Sri Lankan Educators (CAPSLE) will build the teaching, research, publication, collaboration, and fundraising skills of junior faculty members and senior doctoral students in *engineering and business*. The CAPSLE will utilize *active*, *hands-on learning* in a series of panels, lectures, and workshops focused on specific topics to assist young, promising academics to better identify research problems, utilize innovative methodologies, build teaching skills, attract research grants, collaborate with others, and launch their careers on strong foundations. In particular, the CAPSLE will encapsulate identifying *relevant* and *impactful* research in the Sri Lanka context.
